OBD Installation Instructions

- 1. Make sure the vehicle is parked on level ground prior to installing the OBD device.
- Locate the OBDII socket. The location will vary 2. between different vehicle manufacturers, models, and production years.
- 3. Carefully insert the OBD into the OBDII socket.
- Once installed the LEDs will be blinking at a fast rate initially (about 3 blinks per second), which means: 4a.

Red OBD LED – Device has not discovered the OBD-II protocol

Green GSM LED – Device has not obtained GSM/GPRS registration

Blue GPS LED – Device has not obtained a GPS lock

As the device connects to the network, obtains a GPS location, and discovers the OBD-II protocols, the LEDs will: 4b.

Red OBD LED - Once a protocol is discovered through the OBD port, the red LED will flash at a slow rate

Green GSM LED – While the unit is transmitting, the green LED is lit continuously

Blue GPS LED – Once a GPS location is acquired, the LED will flash a slow rate
